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## Affidavit of support form philippine consulate dubai

The consulate may, through consular officials, notarised documents signed by persons used or presented in the Philippines. The notarial document has an ACKNOWLEDGMENT with a gold loop and a seal. THE PERSONAL APPEARANCE OF SIGNATORIES OR SIGNATORIES IS A REQUIREMENT FOR CONSULAR NOTATION. If you have a document notarised or issued by federal, state, county, city, university, school official outside its consulate jurisdiction, please check [here](#) or [here](#) with the consulate, which has the competence to authenticate your document. If you live in or in an area near San Diego in California, you may have your signed documents notarised as a gold seal for the Philippine honorary consul in San Diego. [Click here for the Philippine Honorary Consul's San Diego address] The consular officer reserves the right to refuse to serve customers who do not comply with proper offices and health standards. PROCEDURE Before you go to the consulate, do the following: make a meeting here. Complete and sign the number of forms you need notarised. The sample forms can be found here. You can create your own form or fill out a form by the Philippine authority/institution that you fill out. Make sure that you need a number of original documents that you want to notarial and a copy of this document. For example, you need a Special Power of Attorney and an act of selling notarized. Each original notarised document must have a copy. You can also present a valid identity card (e.g. driving licence, national identity card or passport) with the same full name and signature in the documents. Each notarised copy must have a copy of the valid identity card. Same instructions as there are other signatories who will go to the consulate with you. For example, you need a special power of attorney and a sales act notarised and there are three (3) signatories. Both documents notarised are their own photocopies; both notarised documents and copies thereof must contain copies of each valid identity card of the signatory. Take your pens with you. Bring your United States Postal Service (USPS) priority mail/priority mail express envelope. USPS Priority Mail Envelope must be self-addressed, prepaid by post and USPS tracking. To calculate the amount of postage in the USPS Flat Envelope, see here. The Consulate assumes no responsibility for passports/documents posted through the USPS. If you arrive at the consulate after a pre-inspection in the lobby waiting room: take the elevator to the 5th floor. Line up and wait until you get to the gray officer, when you get to the gray officer, the last one on the initial screening, will give you your ticket number. If your ticket number is called in, in the notarial window with original documents, with a valid id card (examples: license, national id card or passport) with the same full name and signature in your documents and photocopies of documents and valid identity card, and a valid id card with the same full name and signature in your documents. The processor instructs you to go to the cashier to pay a confirmation fee of \$25 for the original notarised document in cash, a cashier check or a U.S. postal order paid by the Philippine Consulate General in Los Angeles only. For example, one original notarized Special Attorney and one original notarised act donation cost a total of \$50. After your official receipt, you can exit the consulate and track your documents 24 hours later by entering your USPS tracking number here: [Kirstin Bernabe-Santos / Dubai Filed on August 28, 2020](#) | Last updated August 28, 2020 at 7:31am Filipino expats must now earn at least Dh10,000 to secure a supportive travel document for their family members visiting the UAE, according to a new policy implemented by Philippine missions. The new income requirement for the written statement of support and guarantee was part of an updated policy that entered into force on 24 April 2004. The details were published on the websites of the Consulate General of the Philippines and the Embassy of Abu Dhabi. For one expat who wants to sponsor a relative's UAE visit, he must prove dh10,000 monthly income. In the case of a married couple, however, Dh14 000 of the total income, the policy has stated. A family of four - either a spouse with two children or a single parent with three children - can claim dh18 000 total income. Previously, the wage claim for this document was only dh3,500. Expats sign an affidavit guarantee that they can support their relatives during their stay in the UAE. Traveling visitors usually present a document to immigration officials in Manila before boarding. While THE ASG has sparked controversy in the past, Philippine authorities have explained that it was part of measures aimed at combating human trafficking and illegal recruitment. The applicant may complete an affidavit that sponsors a relative only in the first and second degree consanguinity or affinity, the policy added. This means that the document can only be issued to the parents, spouses, children, grandparents, siblings, grandchildren and relatives of the expat.
